

PROGRAM DETAILS

The Coyotes organization is a SEMI competitive all-star division of the seaway Valley Soccer Club. All players must be registered in house league and attend house league games at the Kinsmen fields in Cornwall.

Objectives

1. Teach the players how to work in a team environment.
2. Improve their soccer skills
3. Stay active and have fun
4. Respect one and other win or lose

Tryouts

The teams are selected during the tryout sessions. This season they will be held at the Benson Centre from February 1st to March 6th. Each age group will have 3 - 1 hour sessions. There are minimum and maximum amount of players for each team depending on the age group. Although the coaches have the final say on what players are on the team, the Coyotes organization requires the coaches to have at least 2 impartial assessors assisting with the selection of their teams. These assessors can be friends or other coaches. Parents of kids trying out for the same age group will not be considered impartial.

Everyone is welcome to attend the tryouts. The cost is \$25.00 and must be paid prior to the 1 st tryout and a waiver must be signed.

Practices:

Teams will have 1 practice a week that last approximately 1 1/2 hours. The practices will focus on player development and team building. Locations and times for the practices will be determined by the individual coaches once the teams are selected.

Registration takes place once the tryouts are completed. All players will be informed of the time and location by the individual coaches. At registration you will be completing the registration form, signing the code of conduct, selecting the uniform size and paying the registration cost.

Tournaments:

The Coyotes organization is set up as a group of teams that travels together challenging different cities offering tournaments. A lot of time and research goes into locating and booking these tournaments so we can travel together as an organization. There are many families with children in more than 1 age group. This allows families to potentially free up weekends for other activities. If you have knowledge of a tournament that you would like to participate in please forward the information to one of our committee members or coaches as we are always looking for new areas to explore.

As part of the registration fee all teams will be registered for three tournaments (unless otherwise stated). If there are teams that wish to participate in extra tournaments they will have to be sourced out by the individual team and must not conflict with any of the tournaments scheduled by the Coyotes organization. The coach must also communicate with the parents to ensure that enough players will be attending the extra tournament. There will be an extra cost for these tournaments. The coach will be responsible for collecting the admission fees and forwarding it to the Coyotes organization.

No matter where the tournaments are, sportsmanlike behavior is expected. Arguments with referees and other coaches or parents must be avoided. The coach is responsible for the behavior of the players and their parents at the tournaments and practices; they must try to resolve conflicts in a professional manner according to the code of conduct.

Committee:

A new committee is selected every season. The director is voted in at the SVSC AGM meeting and serves a 2 year term. Together they set the course for the Coyotes organization annually. The committee evaluates previous seasons and adjust specific detail make the experience better year after year. They are all volunteers and are there for the love of the game and/or their children. If you have any questions or suggestions on how we can improve the experience for the players there will be evaluation sheets handed out during the season for all players and parents.
